

Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. Junior Showmanship judges should follow the above.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

AKC Sanctioned 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition

This is a recorded event by the AKC for the Certificate of Merit and Puppy of Achievement certificates.

Section 1 - Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over, but under six months on the first day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.



Thursday & Friday, August 3 & 4, 2023 Breeding Soundness Examination

A breeding soundness examination will be performed by Dr. Orsolya Balogh, DVM, Diplomate of the American College of Theriogenologists (Animal Reproduction) and Dr. Nicole Sugai, DVM, AKC/CHF Theriogenology Resident from the Virginia-Maryland College of Veterinary Medicine, Virginia Tech. Semen will be manually collected from the dog and a complete semen evaluation to include motility, morphology, concentration, and number of breeding doses will be reported. Recommendations will be made on suitability for freezing. The fee is \$75.00.

Test Shipment: Test shipment evaluation will include all portions of the breeding soundness examination, but will also evaluate the ability of semen to withstand chilled shipment conditions. The semen will be processed, centrifugation, and extended, in 3 different extenders over a 48-hour period and packaged according to industry standards. The semen will be evaluated at 24 and 48 hours for survival and motility.

The results will be reported, including all portions of the BSE, longevity and which extender provided the best results. An overall recommendation of the stud dog's ability to survive chilled shipment will be made. The fee is \$100.00 From 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. on Thursday, August 3, 2023 and Friday, August 4, 2023 Appointments will be at 30 minute intervals from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. on a first come, first served basis.
