## Information About the Trial Site; Directions

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**Trial Site** - The trials will be held at Camp Bethel 328 Bethel Road Fincastle, VA 24090. There will be one ring, which will be approximately 40 feet by 50 feet in size. The surface will be ribbed matting.

Please clean up after your dogs and yourselves. Pooper scoopers and trash bags will be available for clean-up. Please be considerate of others. We would like to be invited back.

There will be food items available for purchase on both Saturday and Sunday. Beverages and snacks will also be available. There is a selection of restaurants within a short distance from the trial site.

**Directions from I-81 South: take exit 156 VA-542/US-11 and turn right onto State Route 640**

**Directions from I-81 North: take exit 156 VA-542/US-11 and turn left onto State Route 640**

**Then follow these directions: At the T junction (0.4m), Turn left onto US-11N. Drive 2.4 miles and turn right onto VA- 606. At the T junction turn right on state Rte640/VA- 606. After 0.1 mile, turn left on VA 606/Bethel Road. Camp Bethel will be on your right.**

## Transfers

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Transfers (including transfers between an “A” and “B” class at the same level) must be made in writing and must be received by the Trial Secretary in accordance with the AKC’s Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16a. For transfers made prior to October 5, 2019, emails will be accepted as long as the email includes the dog’s call name and AKC registration number, owner’s name, original class entered, and new class requested. For transfers made at or on the days of the shows, the request must be made on AKC approved forms which are available online at the AKC’s website, [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org) or from the Trial Secretary.

## Notice to Exhibitors

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**These Trials will be held indoors and run concurrently. There is plenty of space for Indoor Crating. Please note there are separate entry forms for the Obedience trials and the Rally trials.**

### **Entry Fees Are As Follows:**

First Entry of a dog	\$27
Second Entry of the same dog in the same trial	\$22

Entry fees include all applicable AKC event service and recording fees. Please make the checks payable to “Roanoke Kennel Club, Inc.” or “RKC, Inc.” and be careful when calculating entry fees. Each trial is separate. Entering the same dog in multiple trials on the same day requires a “First Entry” fee for each event. **Please contact the Trial Secretary if you have questions. Overpayments of less than \$5 will not be refunded.**

**Closing Date For Entries: 6:00 PM, Wednesday, November 6, 2024.**

**Entries Will Not Be Accepted Without Fees.** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, except for bitches who come into season after the closing date, for whom RKC will refund the applicable entry fee less \$5 per run, per day. Exhibitors need not provide a veterinarian’s certificate; your word is your honor. However, the Trial Secretary must be notified no later than thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

Overnight or express mail must be sent with “No Signature Required”. Entries will not be accepted by phone, email, hand delivery, or fax. Unless entry limits are reached on an earlier date, entries close on Wednesday, November 6, 2024 (at 6:00 pm EDT) after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

**Entries Must Be Submitted on An Official American Kennel Club Form**, signed by the owner or authorized agent. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry forms are not acceptable. Unsigned entry forms, as well as entry forms that are delivered by e-mail or facsimile transmission, will not be accepted.

**Please Remember** to include the dog's jump height for **ALL** classes in the Obedience Trials and the Rally Trials. The running order for these classes will be as follows:

A Preliminary Confirmation of the receipt of an entry will be made as soon as practicable if an exhibitor legibly includes an active e-mail address on the completed entry form. A final confirmation of an entry and the judging schedule will be forwarded to each exhibitor after the closing date. If you have not received a final confirmation within four days of the trial date, please contact the Trial Secretary. **The final confirmation and judging schedule will be sent by e-mail unless the exhibitor does not have an active e-mail account or unless the exhibitor specifically requests otherwise, in which case the final confirmation and judging schedule will be sent by US mail.**

**No Entry** shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check. Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted after entries have closed.

**Owners Are Responsible** for errors in making out entry forms, whoever makes such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such error or cancellation of entries after the closing date.

**If Because** of riot, wars, civil disturbances, extreme weather conditions, national emergencies, health emergencies, or other acts beyond the control of RKC, it is not possible, in the sole judgment of the Show Committee, to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as snowstorms, ice, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, extreme cold, heavy rains, or other conditions that may affect the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators, including the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or ingress and egress from the grounds, may be considered by the Show Committee in making any determination to open or complete the trial.

**RKC Reserves the Right** to decline any entries or remove a dog from an obedience or rally trial for cause. No dogs under the age of six months may be entered in the trial, and no dogs will be allowed in the trial area except those entered in the trial. No dogs will be allowed in the building prior to opening. No dogs will be allowed in the rings unless they are being judged.

**RKC Will Allow** the Trial Secretary to enter dogs owned or co-owned by the secretary in an obedience or rally trial and will allow the secretary to handle dogs in an obedience or rally trial. In addition, dogs owned or co-owned by any member of the trial secretary's household may be entered in an obedience or rally trial.

**Please prepay if you wish to purchase a catalog.** The cost of a pre-paid catalog is \$5, and you should check the box on the entry form and include payment of \$5 per catalog with your entry fees. A limited number of additional catalogs will be available at the trial at a cost of \$8 each.

**Neither RKC nor Camp Bethel Assume Any Responsibility** for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property. Children are the responsibility of their parents and must be under control at all times.

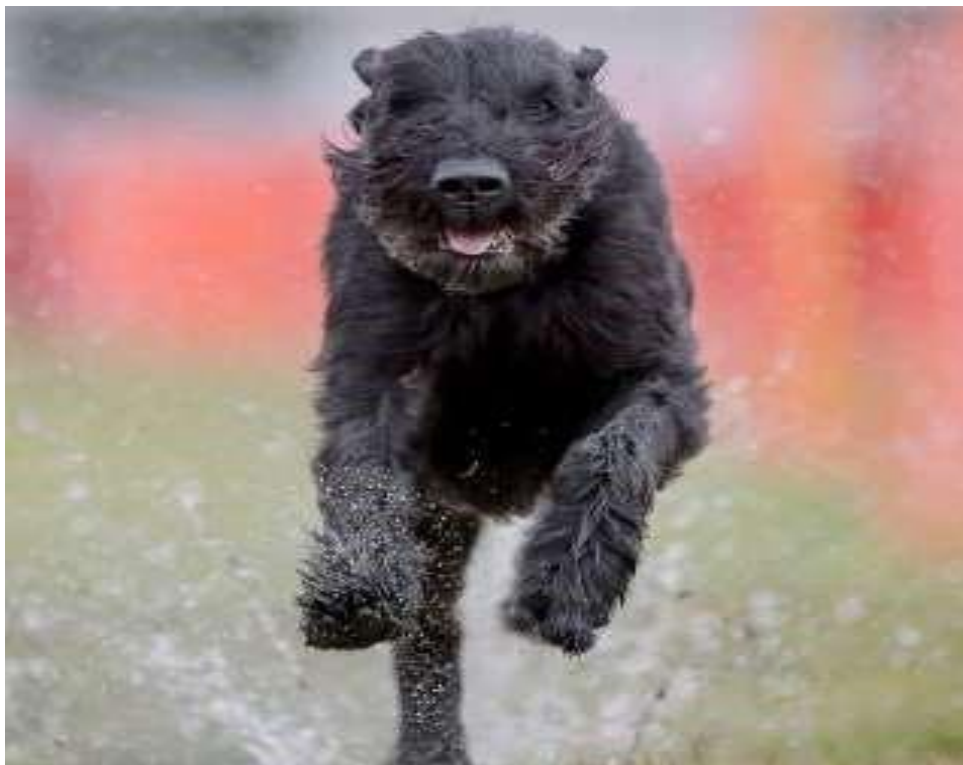

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
  2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., A or B division.
  3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
  4. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All-American Dog and must include their AKC Number on their entry form and check the AKC No. Box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed dogs.

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
  2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., A or B division.
