Rugs are not allowed in the Show Building.

CRATING: All crates (up to & including #400) must be stacked.

Exhibitors & handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in & around their crates.

SHOW GUIDELINES: All dogs **MUST** be kept under control at all times. For this reason we ask that exhibitors not use flexi-leads in the grooming area or show building.

Individual exhibitors will be allowed to take photos intended for personal use only, but only the Show Photographer may take Show Photos.







Pee Wee Class Roanoke Kennel Club, Inc. Friday & Saturday



- ★ For kids from 5 & Under 9 years of age (with a parent or guardian)
- ★ All dogs must be at least four (4) months of age to be exhibited.
- ★ All dogs must wear a proper collar with leash.
- ★ Entry Fee is FREE.
- ★ Entries accepted at the Announcer's Table until 30 minutes before ring time.

The Pee Wee Event is for children from the ages of 5 to under 9 years of age. Each Pee Wee class consists of the child and a responsible adult which must be in the ring with the Pee Wee. The dog must be at least 4 months of age and have the proper lead and collar. At an All-Breed event, all AKC fully recognized and Miscellaneous Class breeds are allowed to enter, including dogs with a PAL listing. In addition, FSS breeds and All-American dogs may be allowed at the discretion of the Club. The responsible adult is responsible for the control of the dog outside the ring. Clubs must provide an additional lead if the mentor inside the ring feels that it is necessary for the safety of the dog and the Pee Wee. EYE CLINIC

Eye Exams for Eye Certification Registry (OFA) (Indirect Ophthalmoscopy & Slit-lamp Biomicroscopy) will be conducted by J. Phillip Pickett, DVM, DACVO Professor Emeritus, Ophthalmology VA/MD CVM, Virginia Tech from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. on THURSDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2025. Walk Ins Only. The dog's pupils will be dilated for the exam; therefore owners may wish to have their dog examined after competition. Positive identification is not required, but is highly recommended by OFA. Microchip readers will be available.

Cost for the CERF exam is **\$50.00**. Checks should be made payable to: James River Kennel Club, Inc. Inquiries may be sent to debstraw@aol.com

Semen Evaluation Clinic

A breeding soundness examination will be performed by a board certified theriogenologist from the Theriogenology Department and one of the AKC/CHF Theriogenology Residents from the Virginia-Maryland College of Veterinary Medicine, Virginia Tech.

Breeding Soundness Examination (BSE)

Semen will be manually collected from the dog and a complete semen evaluation to include motility, morphology, concentration, and number of breeding doses will be reported. Recommendations will be made on suitability for breeding and potential for freezing. The fee is \$130.00.

Test Shipment

Test shipment evaluation will include all portions of the breeding soundness examination, but will also evaluate the ability of semen to withstand chilled shipment conditions. The semen will be processed, centrifuged and extended, in 2 different extenders over a 48-hour period and packaged according to industry standards. The semen will be evaluated at 24 and 48 hours for survival and motility. The results will be reported, including all portions of the BSE, longevity and which extender provided the best results. An overall recommendation of the stud dog's ability to survive chilled shipment will be made. **The fee is \$155.00. From 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. on THURSDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2025 & FRIDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2025.** Appointments will be at 30 minute intervals from 9:00 A.M. - 4:00 P.M. or on a first come, first serve basis. **Make check payable to:** James River Kennel Club, Inc.

Echocardiograms (includes an Auscultation exam) for OFA Certification will be conducted by Ryan Peiffer, DVM, MS, DACVIM (Cardiology) Cardiologist, CVCA Richmond 1616 Three Chopt Road, Henrico, VA, 23233. **From 9:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. on FRIDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2025.** Echocardiograms are by appointment and must be pre-paid by check by **September 30, 2025**. Dr Peiffer is asking for a minimum of 20 Echo exams. Owners will be notified and checks will be shredded if the limit is not reached. Walk in Auscultation exams will still be available if the Echo exams are cancelled. **The fee is \$275.00.** This is done as a pre-breeding or in-breeding examination. Dr. Peiffer is board certified by the ACVIM in the specialty of Cardiology. Positive identification is not required, but is highly recommended by OFA. Microchip readers will be available. RESPIRATORY FUNCTION GRADING CLINIC



A Respiratory Function Grading clinic will be offered for Bulldogs, French Bulldogs, and Pugs on Saturday and Sunday this year. This is a new test that was developed by the Royal Kennel Club and The University of Cambridge and is recognized by the OFA. This test will allow breeders to receive guidance on lowering the risk of producing brachycephalic obstructive airway syndrome (BOAS) in their puppies and breed. (<https://ofa.org/diseases/rfgs/>).

All dogs must be over 12 months of age for OFA certification and any dog under 24 months of age will need to have a repeat examination at or over 24 months of age (yearly exam). Each examination will take 20 - 30 min. and require a short brisk walk for 3 min. Cost is \$60.00 per dog. (Pending OFA approval)

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.





4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
